What:

No dog is perfect! But, how do you create a training plan that gets maximum improvement in an efficient use of time - and keeps the dog (and handler!) happy? We will use some video clips to identify issues, and discussion to create a training plan.

Goal: students leave with a methodology to troubleshoot training issues and create a plan.

Participants will receive an email a week before with some video clips and other "homework" before the zoom meeting.
