### 1994 NEBCA Fall Foliage Championship

The trial season is fast winding down with but a few trials left to be run. It has been an exciting year with some exciting new dogs running on the circuit, as well as our favorite teams from previous years running strong. There have been added some very difficult trials and the quality of dogs as well as handling cannot help but benefit from the challenge of this competition. In 1994, the Pennsylvania Championship at Hop Bottom saw added days, new tougher sheep and an extended course. The Bittersweet Trial was back again with its large rolling field and Barbados Sheep, Canaday's Trial had a larger course, Foster Fields ran unbroke Kathadins, Steve Wetmore added a new, challenging hillside course with streams and outside sheep that were unfamiliar with his fields and Eve Marschark's new trial had a very difficult course with a marathon drive and cross-drive. (We will have complete trial coverage in the next NEBCA News.)

Those dogs that placed well and are running in the Fall Foliage did not earn that honor by placing well in easy trials! We would encourage spectators to come out nd see the best in the Northeast compete against one another for the coveted title of NEBCA Fall Foliage Champion.

This years championship offers new sheep, a new location, new judging and possibly a new double lift. The 1994 Fall Foliage Championship will take place on Saturday, October 8th and 9th at Janet Larson's Lamprey River Farm in Lee, New Hampshire starting at 9:00 am. The competition will consist of two standard runs on Saturday and a third run on Sunday, possibly entailing a Double-lift. The dogs and handlers will be challenged by Gene Sheninger's Kathadin sheep which will be trucked up from New Jersey. These are the difficult sheep that were run at the Foster Field Trial over Labor Day and should offer a test to dog and handler alike. This year we have opted for a panel of three judges: Bernie Armata from Esperance, NY, Tom Forrester from Virginia and Doug McDonough from Andover Connecticut. Each will have a clerk of his own and the scores for each run will then be averaged. (Currently, we need clerks for two of the judges and some additional sheep handlers.)

Prom I 95, take Spaulding Turnpike/East, Exit 6 (Pease Airforce Base/White Mountains). Take last exit, Exit 4 west, (Durham, Concord). Proceed to Lee Traffic Circle, and go SOUTH on 125. Go about one mile. Turn LEFT after Wheelwright Pond and S&J Transportation onto Bennet Rd. At intersection of 155 – STOP!. Go straight across to Lee Hook Rd. Lamprey River Farm is 3/4 miles down on the right.

From Vermont/West: Take I-89 EAST to

I-93 NORTH. At Concord, take Exit 15, I-393 EAST(Portsmouth/Seacost) to To Rt. 4 EAST. At the second traffic circle (Lee), go SOUTH for about 1-mile on 125. Then proceed as above.

From Mt. Washington Valley: Go SOUTH on Rt 16. Take exit 12 to 125 SOUTH. Proceed as above.

From Central Mass. or CT: Take I-84 to Mass. Pike, North. Get off onto I-290 (Worchester) to I-495 NORTH. At Haverhill, get off at exit 51-B. (125 NORTH/Haverhill/Plaistow, NH). Stay on 125 NORTH until you come to Rt 155 (Lee). Go RIGHT onto 155. About 1-1/2 miles past the Rt 152 intersection, take a RIGHT onto Lee Hook Rd. Lamprey River Farm is 3/4 miles down on right.

# Trial Results

### Northeast Independence Day Trial July 2, 3 & 4, 1994 Canaday Farm, Altamont, New York

This is the second year for this New York Trial. Once again the trial felt more like a vacation camp than a competition. There are always a large number of handlers and they come from a wide variety of states to compete. This year there were handlers from all of New England, New York, Maryland, Virginia, Canada, New Jersey and elsewhere! Fellow handlers donated their time to help judge the nursery classes while the open was judged by Ralph Pulfer. Mike and Pat always have a good amount of food and this year was no exception. There was great food each night and good company all weekend continuing to keep this a favorite trial for many.

The nursery classes ran Mike's wool sheep while the open classes were challenged with his Barbs. The field in open was expanded for the trial making the outrun about 350 yards with the drive and cross drive legs each about 200 yards. The sheep were difficult to shed, and the winning runs were deserving of the credit they received. The results, from Warren Mick, are listed below.
