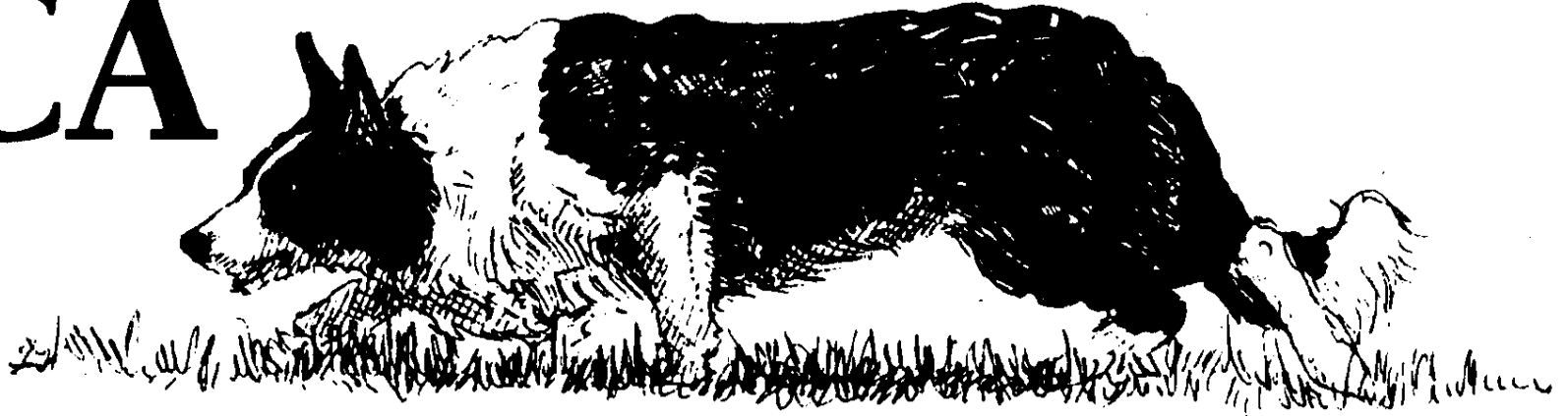

The Fall Foliage Trial will be held at Hampshire College. The students will help in the sheep pens, etc. Ellen said she thinks the college has insurance. Judges for the trial could be one of the following: John Templeton, Stuart Davidson, Roddy McDermott. Eve Marschark mentioned looking into having enamel pins for awards.
