Entries Must be Received by September 5, 2002

Time: Ranch class will run first on on Saturday, September 14th with a handler's meeting no earlier than 6:30. Pro-Novice and then Novice will follow.

Qualifying: To qualify for the Nursery Finals, a dog must have achieved at least one point in the current trail season in the class that you plan to enter and you must be a current NEBCA member. The exact trial format (such as number of runs per dog) will be determined based on the number of entries.

Entry fees: The entry fee is \$25.00 per dog.

Prizes: There will be special prizes for the 1st and 2nd place winners in each class. Plus - if you have owned your dog since it was 6 months of age or younger and trained it yourself, you will be eligible for the "Long Road Award". Sign up on the entry form.

Directions:

Take Route 44 to Route 105 North (which is also Plympton Street). At approximately 0.5 miles, Route 105 turns left. Plympton Street continues straight. Stay on Plympton Street. Proceed approximately 1.5 miles. Bear left at the fork (again staying on Plympton Street). 400 feet after the fork, turn left at the Eddy Homestead onto Cedar Street. Continue approximately 0.6 miles and turn right onto Soule Street. The Soule Homestead/Sheepdog Junction field is approximately 0.5 miles on the left.

FROM THE NORTH: Take Interstate-95 South or Route 24 South to Interstate-495 South. Take Exit 6 to Route 44 East and follow directions above.

FROM THE SOUTH: Take Interstate-95 North or Route 24 North to Interstate-495 South. Take Exit 6 to Route 44 East and follow directions above.

FROM THE WEST: Take the Mass Pike (Interstate-90) to Exit 11A Interstate-495. Go South on I-495. Take Exit 6 to Route 44 East and follow directions above.

Bloomfield Sheep Dog Trial Bloomfield, CT- July 20-23

The weather was blasting hot and the ground was rough. The field was over 1200 yards wide and about 400 yards deep the way the dogs were run. The field was fairly flat with a bit of up and down to it. The handler and the sheep were each on a slight high spot so visibility was good, although the dog spent crucial time at the end of the outrun out of sight. The drives were also very big with the drive away about 150 yards and a cross drive of almost 200 yards. The whole course proved to be very challenging especially with the hot weather. Judge, Kent Kuykendall, was kept busy loping off the points all day but managed to keep his pen as sharp for the last run as it was for the first.

On Sunday the drive was reversed and the cross drive was shortened slightly. The pen was also eliminated and the time on the course was shortened. The sheep proved to be extremely hard to shed on Saturday and nearly impossible on Sunday with very few completed runs. To take advantage of the enormous field available for the trial the dogs with the top ten combined scores from both days were run back in a double lift final with an additional \$1,000 purse on Sunday afternoon. The dogs all proved to be in good condition and were undeterred by the heat. Joan and Bob McGrath donated enormous, silver champagne coolers for overall trophies in each class. These were avidly sought by all of the handlers and carried away with considerable satisfaction by a lucky few. Sally Lacy contributed a beautiful watercolor of a border collie for first prize in the double lift. Emily Yazwinski donated a handknit sweater for the raffle which raised hundreds of dollars along with other donations for the trial.
